Then hang up. When the line is no longer busy, a special ring will let you know. Pick up the phone to connect the call.

How to use Continuous Redial

- When you get a busy signal, hang up, pick up the receiver again and press ***66**.
- Hang up. Continuous Redial will automatically continue to dial the number, for up to 30 minutes.
- When the line is no longer busy, a distinctive ring lets you know. Simply pick up the phone and the call will connect.
- You can activate Continuous Redial on up to 15 numbers simultaneously. The feature works with most local and some long-distance numbers within your area.
- You can continue to place and receive calls while Continuous Redial is activated.
- If you want to stop the Continuous Redial on a number, just lift the receiver and press *86.

For rotary phones

If you are using a rotary-dial telephone instead of a touch-tone phone, dial O in place of the \bigstar key. For example \bigstar 66 is O 66 on rotary phones.
